ABOUT THIS COURSE

Making informed decisions requires understanding of risk and benefits of our alternatives, the technology involved and the factors affecting our decisions. Risk management and safety engineering is a discipline that provides the technique and tools to evaluate the effects and benefits or engineering decision alternatives, allowing decision makers to make risk-informed decision. This Risk Management and Safety Engineering Certificate Course consists of a series of training workshops that covers the key techniques and tools commonly use in risk assessment and decision-making analyses.

This introductory course, which is the first of the series providing structured, applied and practical approach in conducting risk assessments and decision analyses, addresses the basic concept and theory in Risk Management and Safety Engineering, as well as providing an overview of the common tools and techniques in safety risk assessment. This course is necessary for participants to capture the basic knowledge for future workshops on Intermediate and Advanced Topics in Risk Management and Safety Engineering course.
