Asian Security Industry Growth in the Spotlight

Escalating political tensions and terrorism concerns have forced governments in Asia to face new security demands and challenges. Research has found that the annual security market growth rate in Asia-Pacific countries is 7.5%, reaching over US\$ 3 billion by 2015. Over 85% of the world's security products are made in Asia. Ranging from video surveillance, access control to intrusion alarm, China, Japan, South Korea, Taiwan, Singapore and Malaysia are the major supplying countries and regions for the global security markets. International companies with proven technologies are able to add value to the mix, offering integrated solutions capabilities and service.


In addition to homeland security, growth areas reflect the dynamics of the Asian economies, including banking, transportation, hospitality, retail and infrastructure development as well as the educational and healthcare sectors.

Much of the demand for the latest security and fire protection industries reflect moves away from people based security hightech solutions. By 2020 it is expected that China's security and safety market will be worth US\$30 billion, combining high definition configurations with the latest CCTV and surveillance technologies.




